# Programs

### Life Skills Experience

The Life Skills Experience allows participants ages 3-18 to progress through the program over time, deepening their understanding of life skills and golf development. Every participant has the opportunity to:

- Learn the game of golf and how it relates to life
- Focus on interpersonal and self-management skills on and off the golf course
- Set goals and put strategies in place to make them a reality
- Learn conflict resolution, resilience and how to plan for the future

#### **School Based**

Through our School Based Programs, we partner with local schools and districts to help deliver exposure to golf for all ages.

The program creates an environment where young people experience the lifelong sport of golf while learning basic motor skills, golf skills, social skills, character development and health and wellness.

### Community

Our Community Programs are specifically designed for youth development organizations to give kids the chance to learn about golf and develop character through fun golf games. Each activity empowers young people to explore their abilities and develop lifeenhancing values along the way.

Mary has volunteered with First Tee — Southern Colorado for 6 years, she started volunteering because she wants kids to see that golf is a sport for a lifetime and she wants young women and girls to see their place in the world of golf. She recently shared a story of one of our participants that had an impact on her.

"He began as a "Tiny Tee," as the youngest kids were called. Paying attention was a challenge, session after session. Wiggly, distracted, we sought every which way to reach him, constant "eyes on coach!" admonishments seemed to be unheard. A couple of years in, during a summer session, he was noticeably more focused, and was enjoying each session, really trying to do each skill. I knew our lessons had been learned when he confidently stepped to his ball on the green and I heard his address: 'let's sink this sucker!'"

Throughout 2021 our chapter focused on three main Key Performance Indicators:

- 90% of black/Hispanic participants in our programs will improve in academics and/or behavior through the life skills and core values we teach.
- Increase Life Skills Experience programs with youth serving organizations that serve a majority population of Black/Hispanic youth.
- Through First Tee's STEMLinks program, 75% of Black/Hispanic participants will be introduced to STEM.

# Furthering Our Mission



At the end of 2021, we were able to expand our service area to include Pueblo and Fremont Counties, and changed our name to First Tee — Southern Colorado. Our expansion officially kicked off with a partnership with The Boys & Girls Club of Pueblo County. We conducted programs at four of their clubs:

- Eastside Clubhouse
- Irving Clubhouse
- Minnequa Clubhouse
- Sprague Clubhouse

Moving into 2022, we are excited about our future growth in these counties, which will include partnerships with golf courses in each county and new School Based and Community Program locations.








In 2021, we continued efforts to strengthen our financial position to ensure the quality and growth of our programming operations. We are careful stewards of the support we receive, keeping a sharp eye on our expenses and seeking operating efficiencies wherever possible. We were able to grow our reach of participants by 33% from 2020 to 2021. We managed to achieve this growth with only 20% increase in our budget.
