## **A WORD FROM OUR CEO**

Dear Friends of First Tee - Southern Colorado:

It is time to reflect on another historic year for our chapter and the many ways we have made an impact on the lives of our participants. Our staff has continued to excel and grow our programs, but we know our work has only just begun.

Impact is defined as having a strong effect on someone or something. As you review our 2023 Annual Report, you will see that First Tee — Southern Colorado is doing exactly that; making an impact on the lives of youth in Southern Colorado. Through our impactful programming, we reached more than 5,500 kids and teens in our programs and we were able to provide \$113,875 in financial resources to over 75% of our participants.

Because of your support, 2023 was a year of incredible growth for our chapter and participants. We have been able to enhance and widen many of our already fantastic programs – including continuing our expansion and setting up programming in Fremont County, collaborating with impactful partners through our 21 Community Partnership Locations, and rolling out new technology for our participants and coaches.

First Tee — Southern Colorado believes that golf is a perfect practice ground for learning skills that go far beyond the fairways. At all levels, players have the opportunity to play, learn and appreciate the game of golf and how it relates to life, as they focus on the Key Commitments to becoming a Game Changer: Pursuing Goals, Growing through Challenge, Collaborating with Others, Building Positive Self-Identity, and Using Good Judgement.

As an organization we believe in practicing what we teach and in 2024 we will be Pursuing Goals to further the mission of who we are here to serve. With your help and partnership, in 2024 we will:

- Increase the diversity of our kids and teens involved in programming taking our impact, from 65% to 70% or more.
- Focus on retention of pre-teens and teens within Core Programs, with a retention rate goal of over 50%.
- Increase female percentage of participation rates, from 37% to 45% within all of our First Tee Program offerings.

On behalf of our young people, THANK YOU for supporting First Tee — Southern Colorado and allowing us to continue making a great impact. We are so proud and excited to see the incredible growth and intentional impact we have made.

#### **About Us**

Our programs happen daily at golf facilities, schools, and through community partners throughout El Paso, Pueblo, Teller and Fremont Counties. Participants ages 3 – 18 progress through the program over time, deepening their understanding of life skills and golf development. The integrated approach helps kids and teens build confidence and resilience for when they are on the course, at home and in school. Every participant has the opportunity to:

- Focus on interpersonal and selfmanagement skills on and off the golf course
- Set goals and put strategies in place to make them a reality
- Learn conflict resolution, resilience and how to plan for the future
- Make healthy choices and use good judgement
- Get out on a golf course to learn the game of golf and how it relates to life









El Paso and Pueblo Counties have seen great growth in participant numbers over the past three years. 2021 was First Tee — Southern Colorado's first year in Pueblo County.



Our coaches' ability to develop impactful relationships with our participants is the backbone of our program.






