As we reflect on an inspiring year at First Tee – Southern Colorado, I am proud to share the many accomplishments and milestones that have made 2024 a year of growth and impact. Our commitment to shaping young lives through character building programs remains unwavering, and thanks to the continued support of our dedicated donors, volunteers, and partners, we have taken significant strides in empowering the next generation of leaders.

In 2024, we continued to build on our mission of empowering young people through the game of golf, using it as a platform to teach essential life skills and core values. Our programs reached over 5,200 kids and teens across Southern Colorado, helping them build confidence, develop leadership abilities, and foster a sense of responsibility. Every day, we see how golf's timeless lessons—respect, integrity, perseverance—are shaping the next generation of leaders in our community. In 2024 we set big goals, but we achieved remarkable milestones!

- We empowered 1,193 future leaders through multi-week programs at green grass facilities, teaching life and golf skills with the support of our dedicated coaches and mentors.
- Achieved a retention rate of 49% for preteens and teens aged 10+, closely approaching our goal of 50% retention through core programming.
- 59% of our participants came from ethnically diverse backgrounds, actively engaging in our programs and enriching the experience for all.
- We grew our female participation across all programs to 47%, helping girls to thrive through the game of golf.

None of this would be possible without the unwavering commitment of our staff, volunteers, and donors. Together, we are making a meaningful difference in the lives of youth across Southern Colorado. Your belief in our mission allows us to continue to provide access to high-quality programs that teach important values both on and off the course.

As we look ahead to 2025, we are excited for the continued expansion of our initiatives. We remain committed to ensuring that every child, regardless of their background or circumstances, has the opportunity to experience the positive impact of golf and life skills development. I invite you to join us in our efforts as we continue to nurture our community's youth, providing them with the tools to succeed in life—both in sports and beyond. # **Strategic Plan**


Throughout 2024 we developed a comprehensive strategic plan that will be executed in 2025-2027. Our focus areas are:

- Leverage **marketing** to drive enrollment, awareness, and fundraising



El Paso and Pueblo Counties have seen sustainable growth in participant numbers over the past three years; our partnership locations expanded our reach in both counties.



Participation in Teller County has remained consistent over the past three years. 2023 marked our inaugural year in Fremont County, and we saw substantial growth in 2024.



Our year-round, multi-week **Core Program** offers a research-backed curriculum that emphasizes core values and life skills. Delivered through age-appropriate programming, it seamlessly integrates a range of golf skills and fundamentals, typically at premier golf facilities.

Our chapter-led **Outreach Programs** introduce golf to youth of all ages, focusing on motor skills, social development, character building, and health and wellness. Designed for schools and youth-serving organizations, the program combines engaging golf games with fundamental skill development, while also promoting positive character traits.

Our **Partnership Locations** integrate First Tee – Southern Colorado's program into schools in at-risk communities, establishing long-term partnerships. We provide training and equipment at no cost, allowing schools to implement the program at their convenience. Participating schools must offer the program to every student at least once per year.



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


